

Thank you for your letter of October 28, 2008 regarding the installation of additional security cameras on the Carnegie West Branch Library to view the activity around the library and Novak Park.

I have asked Cleveland Public Library Chief of Security, Michael Janero, to research options for camera installation as expeditiously as possible. When that information is available, I will contact you for further discussion on how we can work together to address this important issue.

While I am aware and sensitive to the safety concerns of our patrons and those residents in the Novak Park neighborhood, I also understand that several streetlights are inoperable and not providing adequate illumination necessary for that area. I am hopeful, that with your support as councilman, immediate repairs to those defective light poles will be made.

As I continue to collect information on the possibilities of camera installation, I welcome updates on your progress as well.
