Ohio Update:Proposed Library Cuts on Hold for Another Week

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Governor's proposal to halve library support generates huge response

[Updated July 7] With budget talks in Ohio again stalemated, the state legislature has approved and Governor Ted Strickland has signed another interim budget extension, lasting through July 14.

[Updated June 29] As budget talks go down to the wire in Ohio, with continuing disagreements about Strickland's lottery plan and cuts in support for libraries (more than \$200 million) and other programs, the state Senate has approved an interim budget that would extend the current budget year one week, through labs 7.

The Ohio Library Council (OLC) reported that, while the measure will fund state programs at 70% of the current level, library funding will remain unchanged. Nevertheless, the OLC said, "Depending on the progress of the budget negotiations, libraries may need to re-energize their efforts to mobilize patrons."








Conceptual Budget by Phase

Phase	* Construction Budget	** Total Project Budget
Phase 1	\$785,000 - \$865,000	\$1,100,000 - \$1,215,000
Phase 2	\$2,770,000 - \$3,050,000	\$3,878,000 - \$4,270,000
Phase 3 (interior)	\$1,185,000 - \$1,300,000	\$1,660,000 - \$1,820,000
Phase 3 (exterior)	\$1,452,000 - \$1,600,000	\$1,743,000 - \$1,920,000
Phase 4	\$1,600,000 - \$1,750,000	\$2,240,000 - \$2,450,000
Phase 5	\$1,165,000 - \$1,280,000	\$1,630,000 - \$1,792,000
	\$8,957,000 - \$9,845,000	\$12,251,000 - \$13,467,000

^{*} Note these costs include items that are necessary for consolidation as well as discretionary items intended to make the Main Library a 'Destination Experience'

^{**} Note these costs are calculate as a 40% increase over construction costs as a conceptual estimate.
